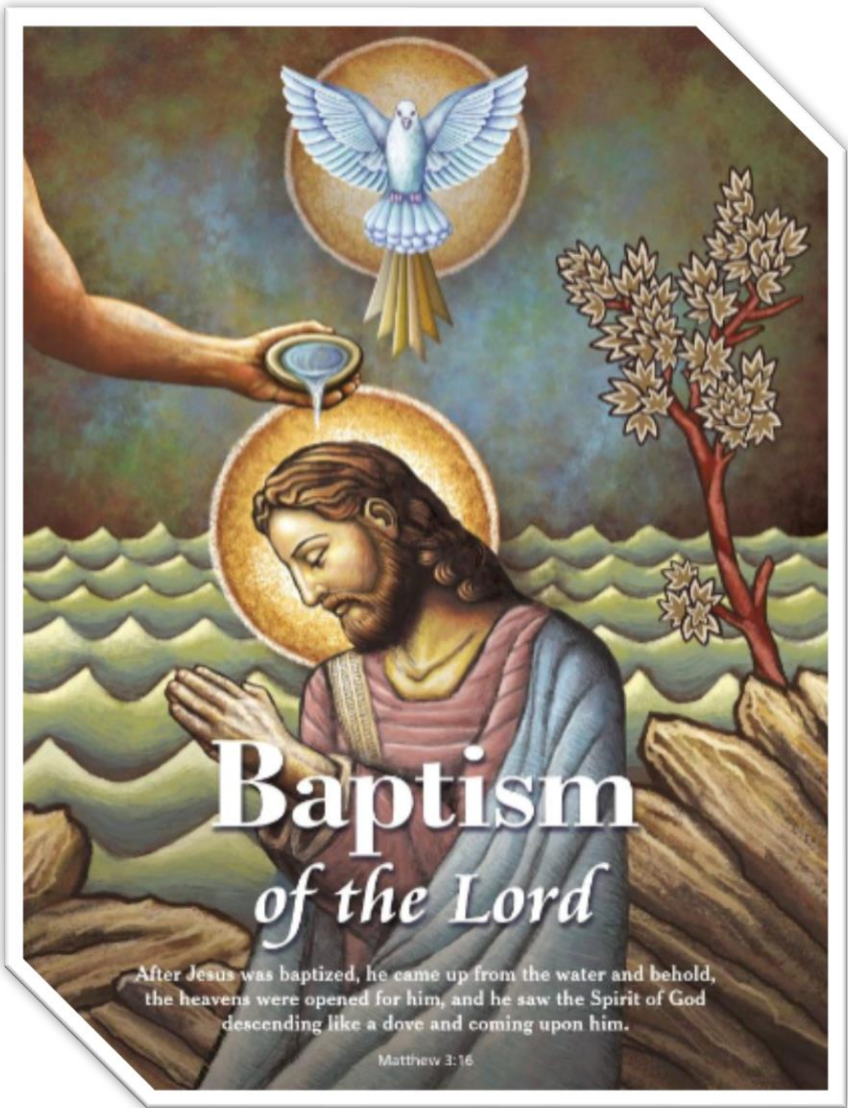

THE PROCLAMATION OF THE WORD

First Reading – Isaiah 43:1-7

Reader: A reading from Isaiah

But now, this is what the Lord says, *He who is your Creator*,
Jacob,

And He who formed you, Israel:

“Do not fear, for I have redeemed you;

I have called you by name; you are Mine!

² When you pass through the waters, I will be with you;

And through the rivers, they will not overflow you.

When you walk through the fire, you will not be scorched,

The Holy One of Israel, your Savior;

I have given Egypt as your ransom,

Cush and Seba in exchange for you.

Reader: A reading from Acts

³⁴ Philip went down to the city of Samaria and *began* proclaiming the Christ to them...¹²when they believed Philip as he was preaching the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were being baptised...¹⁴Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, ¹⁵who came down and prayed for them that they would receive the Holy Spirit. ¹⁶ (For he had not yet fallen upon any on them; they have simply been baptised in the name of the Lord Jesus.) ¹⁷ Then they *began* laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit.

¹⁵ Now while the people were in a state of expectation and they all were thinking carefully in their hearts about John, whether he himself perhaps was the Christ, ¹⁶ John responded to them all, saying, "As for me, I baptize you with water; but He is coming who is mightier than I, and I am not fit to untie the straps of His sandals; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. ¹⁷ His winnowing fork is in His hand to thoroughly clear His threshing floor, and to gather the wheat into His barn; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire...²¹ Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus also was baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened, ²² and the Holy Spirit

descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came from heaven: "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well pleased.

Parents/Sponsors: I will, with God's help.

Rev. Oz: Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Response: I renounce them.

Rev. Oz: Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

Response: I renounce them.

Rev. Oz: Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

Response: I renounce them.

Rev. Oz: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Saviour?

Response: I do.

Rev. Oz: Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

Response: I do.

Rev. Oz: Do you promise to obey him as your Lord?

Response: I do.

Rev. Oz: Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Samuel in his life in Christ?

People: We will.

The Celebration of the Baptism

Thanksgiving over the Water

Rev. Oz: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Rev. Oz: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Rev. Oz: We give you thanks, almighty God and Father,
for by the gift of water you nourish and sustain all
living things.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

Red Sea, you led your people out of slavery to
freedom in the promised land.

Rev. Oz: We give you thanks for sending your Son Jesus.
For us he was baptized by John in the river Jordan.
For us he was anointed as Christ by your Holy Spirit.
For us he suffered the baptism of his own death and
resurrection, setting us free from the bondage of sin
and death, and opening to us the joy and freedom of
everlasting life.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

Rev. Oz: We give you thanks for your Holy Spirit who
teaches us and leads us into all truth, filling us with
his gifts so that we might proclaim the gospel to all
nations and serve you as a royal priesthood.

All: Blessed be God for ever.

Rev. Oz: We give you thanks for you have called
Samuel to new life through the waters of baptism.

Now sanctify this water, that your servants who are washed in it may be made one with Christ in his death and resurrection, to be cleansed and delivered from all sin. Anoint them with your Holy Spirit and bring them to new birth in the family of your Church, that they may become inheritors of your glorious kingdom.

We give you praise and honour and worship through your Son Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and for ever.

reconcile all things in Christ,

and bring us to that city of light
where you dwell with all your sons and daughters;
through Jesus Christ our Lord,
the firstborn of all creation,
the head of the Church,
and the author of our salvation;

by whom, and with whom, and in whom,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
all honour and glory are yours, almighty Father,
now and forever.
